LONG POINT BOATYARD RULES 7/1/2020

The Long Point Boatyard is a storage area for actively used boats, trailers, and docks only. It is not meant to be a boat graveyard. Boats that do not have a current registration and have not been used for two years must be removed from the boat storage area, unless a special arrangement is made with the LP Board of Directors. The Long Point Corporation may remove from the boatyard unused boats and other equipment when the owner has been non-compliant with a request to remove such equipment.

No hazardous materials, waste products, or scrap lumber may be stored in the boat storage area. Boat covers must be maintained in good repair.

All spaces are assigned by the boatyard committee. You need an assigned space to store boats or trailers here. If you would like to know about availability, call Robert Fuller at 802-343-6123 or Dan Berry at 802-349-9010. Do not leave boats or trailers here if you do not have an assigned space.

All boats, trailers & docks must be clearly identified with a weatherproof sign or marking. If your trailer is locked, you must provide the boatyard staff with a key or the combination to the lock.

If you have an assigned space it is your responsibility to keep the grass and weeds cut to less than one foot high.

Boats, trailers, or docks may be moved and spaces reassigned by the boatyard staff to maintain the aesthetics and safety of the boatyard.

Owners agree to use the boatyard at their own risk. Neither Long Point Corporation nor the boatyard staff is responsible for damage to or loss of items stored in the boatyard through vandalism, theft, or other causes.
